

The Five Major Emphases of 2010?

1. Project Samaritan

Be ready with prayer, resources, and connections to persons requesting help. Starting points include developing a useful handbook of community resources, partnering with neighborhood mission centers, enlisting and training members to personally connect those in need with community resources and follow-up.

Timely financial donations have helped us keep pace with increased need in our neighborhood/community. Resource notebooks with prioritized agencies, numbers and emails are available. We are exploring participation with day to day resources like Faith City Missions, Salvation Army, and Washington Street Center.

2. Project Evangelism

Provide training with Scripture and practical outlines for sharing the Gospel of Jesus, our own personal testimony, giving invitation and prayer.

Steve Venable, Pastor Cindy and Pastor Jeff- led "Celebrate Evangelism Training Events", Pastor Cindy led the "Gotta Tell Somebody Series" enabling members to have confidence in sharing faith in grocery stores at Christmas and Burger King one Saturday.

3. Project Discipleship/Training

Provide training for establishing seekers and new believers in the fundamentals of Biblical Christian faith/training for mentoring persons through this Biblical process.

Following Jesus-Steps to a Passionate Faith is currently being studied by 30 students strengthening disciples in Christian fundamentals and preparing them to disciple other believers or seekers.

This summer "Mission Impossible" led by Caleb Rejino (Cindy-Steve assist) will gather and develop a core team of persons who gather for prayer and worship, discovery of mission and implementation of spiritual gifts in and around Amarillo.

4. Project Retreats

Provide short-term, one day, or weekend retreats or seminars to strengthen a particular area of Christian faith while building Christian community.

The Writer's Conference drew sixty area authors, songwriters, etc. Abba Weekend provided a big embrace of youth by our loving God, deep study in the Word, called youth to practice Christian disciplines for discerning God's direction.

Family Weekend is in its final preparation stage-new date being selected.

5. Project Community

Plan monthly outreach project or ministry to make a definite difference in the community, proclaim Christ's love, and consider such outreach for quarterly or year round support.

Truck 'N' Treat, the Children's Christmas Musical/Drama and Easter Jamboree brought church members, friends, and people from the neighborhood together for message, worship, fun, etc. We rejoice new people have come to the church through these events and given us over 40 names for follow-up this summer.
